

Dissemination Activity Organized by the Belgian School within the DiCoRE Erasmus+ Project

At the end of the project event, the Belgian partner school, GO! atheneum Grimbergen, organized a dissemination activity to share the main results, experiences and learning outcomes of the DiCoRE 210 Erasmus+ project — *Digital Competence for Resilient Educators*. The activity aimed to present the work carried out during the event and to increase awareness among teachers, students and the wider school community about the importance of digital competences in modern education.

During the dissemination session, the participants shared information about the project objectives, the activities implemented with the international partners and the new digital tools and methods explored during the event. Special attention was given to innovative teaching approaches, including the use of digital technologies to support critical thinking, creativity, collaboration and student-centred learning.

The Belgian school highlighted how the DiCoRE project contributes to improving teachers' digital skills and encourages the integration of modern educational practices into the school curriculum. Students and teachers also had the opportunity to reflect on the international experience, the cooperation with partners from other countries and the benefits of Erasmus+ projects for personal, professional and institutional development.

The dissemination activity helped to promote the visibility of the Erasmus+ Programme and ensured that the knowledge gained during the event could be shared with a wider audience.
